and again stated that she and her husband mixed up the 4 Gatorade bottles together while Chucky was at work. We were able to obtain lot numbers off of two remaining bottles of orange Gatorade. One PC06E01306:32 the other was PC05E03322:00.

On today's date I spoke with Dr. Sadie of the State lab. He had completed the toxicology analysis on the submitted items. He stated that methanol was found in the following items. Item 6A contained an unknown blue item - 33% methanol: Item 7 orange Gatorade, lot number PC06E01306:32 contained 3.38% methanol: Item 11A lemon lime Gatorade lot number CT37017C02P00:38 - 3.67% methanol; Item 11B fruit punch Gatorade lot number CT37031C02P18:52 - 3.64% methanol: Item 13 fruit punch Gatorade lot number CT37031C02P18:52 4.78% methanol.

Dr. Sadie is sending the items to Tidewater for Ethyleneglycol for analysis, however he feels that the methanol originated from the container of unknown blue liquid containing 33% methanol. He also stated that item 3A which was a yellow substance from a jug did not have any detectable methanol. It is believed that that is antifreeze.

Mrs. Fleming and her son, Jeffrey Tanner came into investigations for interviews and polygraphs. I re interviewed Mrs. Fleming and Det. Ray Ash, Jr. interviewed Jeff. Det. Akers went to Target(Midlothian) to interview Chucky Tanner.

Mrs. Fleming went over the sequence of events of the weekend. She said that Chucky had to work at Food Lion (Deer Run) on Sunday from 1-9 pm. He went with them to Costco from church and went to work from there. Chuck was only at Costco for a few minutes before going home and she, Jeff and Megan shopped. She stopped at GNC (Hull St.) on the way home and purchased the Createne. They got home around 1:30 pm. She and Chuck mixed the Createne with 1 bottle of Gatorade. He tasted it and put it in the refrigerator to cool. At about 2:00 pm Chuck took Megan to the community pool and they returned home around 3:30 pm. He watched TV until approximately 3:45 pm when he left to go play basketball at Swift Creek Middle School. He returned home around 7:00 pm. He drank the bottle of Gatorade and showered. Chuck went to the garage and picked other flavors of Gatorade that he wanted to try with the Createne. He brought 4 bottles in and they (Mr. & Mrs. Fleming) mixed them up. (Mrs. Fleming is not sure if that was before or after his shower). He watched TV, ate a small bowl of ice cream, and went to bed around 9:30 pm, stating he was tired. Mrs. Fleming said he normally went to bed around 10:30 - 11:00 pm. She said when he got up Monday morning he was moaning and sighing heavily. She asked him what was wrong and he said that he did not feel good. He went to work but returned home around 9:00 am. She had been on her way out and passed him on Woodlake Village Dr. She returned home to find him sick. She noticed a stain on his pants and he stated that he had vomited. He laid on the sofa throughout the day and vomited numerous times. He became short of breath and she called 911.

Mrs. Fleming agreed to take a polygraph test. It was administered by Det. Church U678. The results were truthful.
